How to participate

The Auction of Services has gone online. Connect to it at https://cutt.ly/NCFauction2020 any time between Sunday, March 29, 2020 and Sunday, April 12, 2020. You may reconnect as many times as you like, in order to continue bidding.

If you cannot participate online, you may use the bid tally card attached to this list. Give your completed bid tally card to an Auction coordinator. (You may retain the "notes to self" portion if you like.) Your bids will be compared to all other bids at the time the Auction closes. Make sure you put your name on your bid tally card, and make sure your current contact information is in the NCF phone list.

When the Auction closes

The Auction coordinators will review all bids and post the report of who won the bidding on each item (event, good, or service).

In addition to posting the summary who-won-what report, Auction coordinators will contact each individual who participated in the Auction, to confirm what they won (including where and how to collect any goods), and what they owe. This contact process may take several days once the Auction has closed.
